



The Central Indiana Division of the MWR / NMRA held its Annual Business Meeting on April 1, 2017 at Martinsville, IN. A total of 24 members were in attendance.

Superintendent Keith Clark called the meeting to order at 11:12 AM.

MINUTES

* Meeting minutes from the April 2, 2016 Annual CID Business Meeting were distributed and reviewed. Jack Simpson forwarded a motion to approve the April 2016 minutes, with the motion seconded by Dan Hinel. Motion passed.

REPORTS

- * Superintendent Keith Clark recognized the 2016-2017 Board of Directors, extending the CID's appreciation for their service over the past year. Certificates were awarded to all Board members.
- * On behalf of the CID Elections Committee, Doug Rolfe announced the results of the Spring 2017 CID elections. A total of 51 ballots were received, with Dan Hinel, Bill Schoonmaker, and Jim Shellhaas each elected to 2-year Trainmaster terms beginning May 15, 2017. Appointed Trainmaster posts will be announced soon.
- * Steve Studley and Tom Cain reviewed the July 2016 NMRA National Convention, hosted by the CID / NMRA. The program received many compliments, from the 1,300+ participants. Steve and Tom both expressed appreciation to all who helped with registration, tours, clinics, etc. Keith Clark recognized the Chair and Co-Chair with plaques for their leadership of the "successful" Highball To Indy 2016 event.
- * Paymaster Joe Rodenberg reviewed the financial details for the CID:
 - 1) The financial statement for the period January 1, 2016 December 31, 2016 (see attachment) outlined income and expenses for the complete calendar year.
 - 2) CID liabilities and equity totaled \$45,941.57 as of March 31, 2017.
 - 3) For calendar year 2017, the period January 1st March 31st, the balance sheet shows a "positive" of \$1,192.98
 - 4) Newman Atkinson made a motion to approve the Paymaster's report, seconded by Jack Simpson; the motion passed.
- * Chief Clerk Richard Seymour reported on the following:
 - 1) There are approximately 280 on the membership roles of the CID / NMRA.

- The Division's membership topped out at about 357 right after NMRA National Convention in July 2016. Richard mentioned that CID officials reached out to the 70+ local modelers who purchased Rail Pass memberships (and attended the 2016 NMRA conference); several have since renewed at the yearly rate.
- 3) Richard distributed a yearly calendar for 2017, noting events and shows hosted by the CID and other area model railroading groups.
- He reminded everyone that the next meeting of the CID Board of Directors was scheduled for April 9, 2017 (to be held at the Wayne Township Library in Indianapolis). All members are welcome to attend CID meetings.
- * CID webmaster Roger Hensley was recognized for his 20+ years of service to the Division, maintaining the Division's website. Keith Clark and Richard Seymour both noted Roger's dedication in routinely posting notices and photographs about CID activities. He was given a plaque in recognition of his efforts. Note: Roger had handed off the website management responsibilities at the start of 2017.

NEW BUSINESS

- * Steve Studley provided a short preview of the CID's Spring 2016 Layout Tour, inviting members to view the 6 layouts that would be open in and around Bloomington, IN on Saturday, April 22nd.
- * Keith Clark invited members to register for the "Golden Rails" Midwest Regional Convention in Rockford, IL, to be held April 28-30, 2017.
- * Steve Studley and Matt Ahlbrand noted that a late-spring Modeler's Meet will be held at the Columbus (IN) Model Railroad. Two clinics are scheduled for that day, about "operations".
- * Keith Clark noted that the 2017 NMRA Convention will be in Orlando, FL in late July; he encouraged CID members to participate in this year's event.

* Matt Ahlbrand made a motion to adjourn the meeting, with a second by Trevor Jones. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 11:39 AM.
