

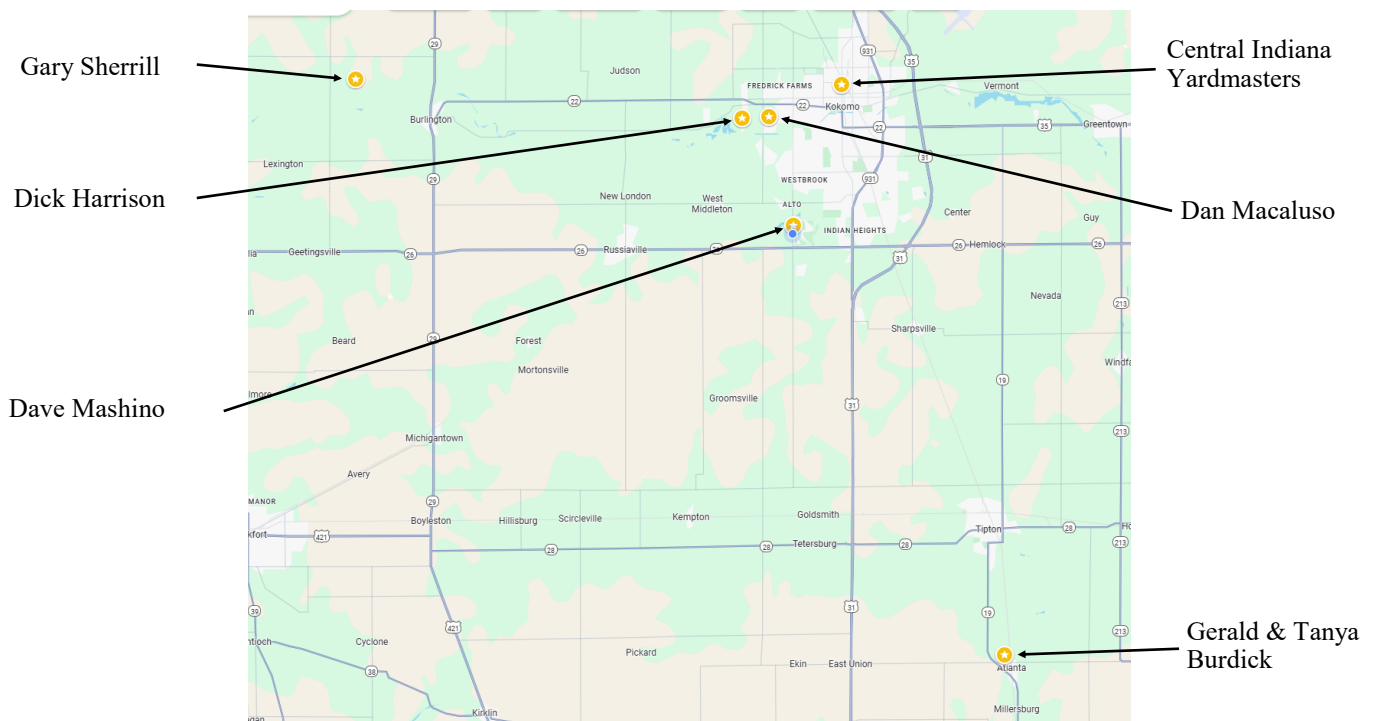

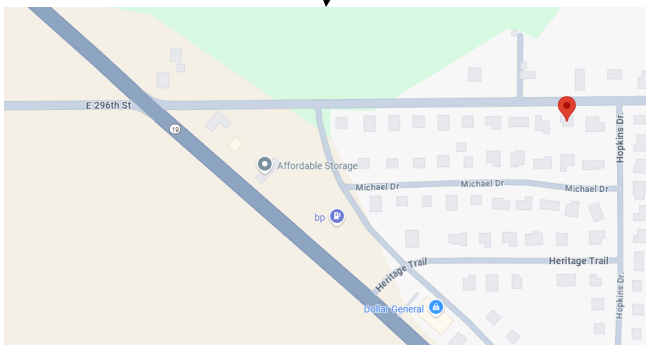
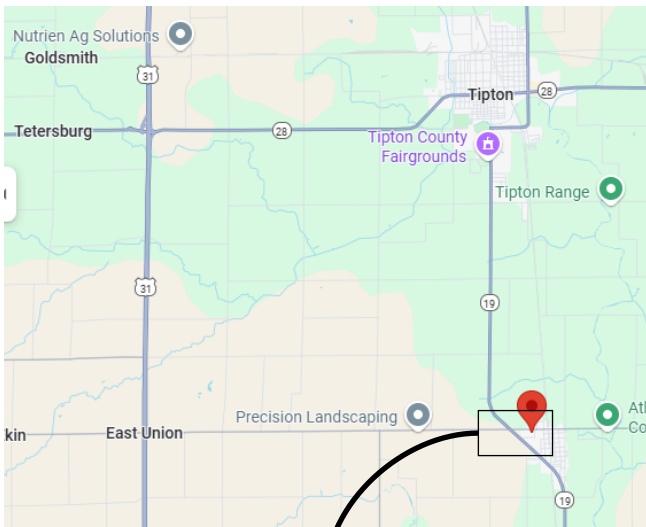

Dan Macaluso's C & O Pere Marquette Division

Simulates towns along Mich Pere Marquette RR with an advanced signal and crossing system with sophisticated train detection and main control panels with remote panels for sidings. Many Lionel and MTH operating accessories. Uses MTH DCS system but can accomodate conventional control. Staging tracks and classification yard with locomotive storage included. Extension to a second room of 28 x 32 ft makes a 64 ft straight track possible.

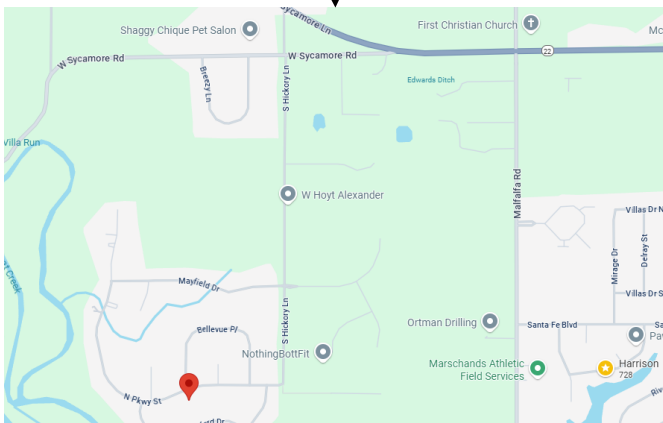
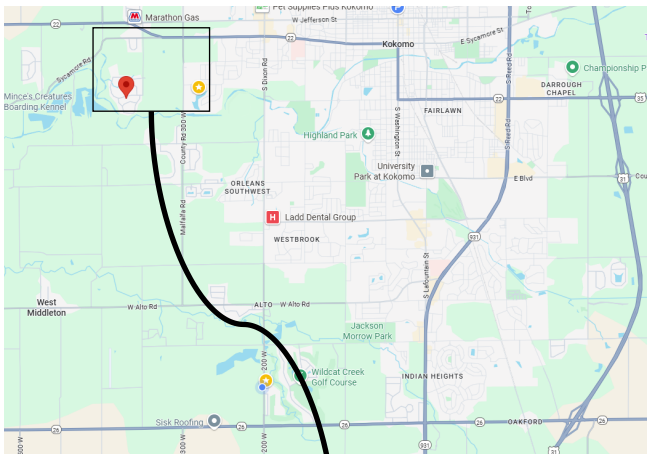

The layout is a walk around configuration with point-to-point operation and an option for continuous running set in the early 20th century where steam locomotives ruled the rails. The two main yards use iPads with JMRI panels to operate servo powered turnouts and uncouplers. The layout also features operating semaphore signals.

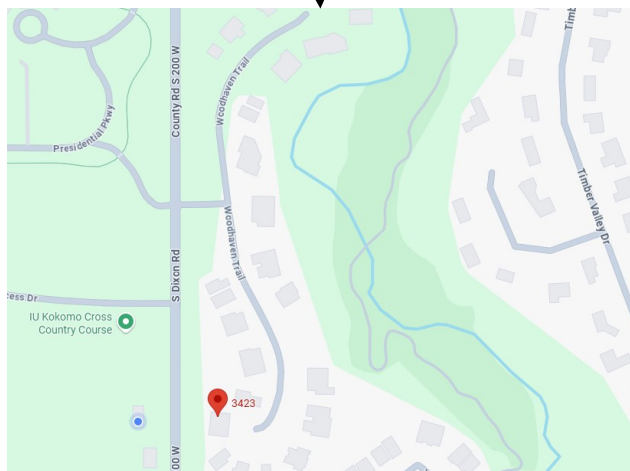
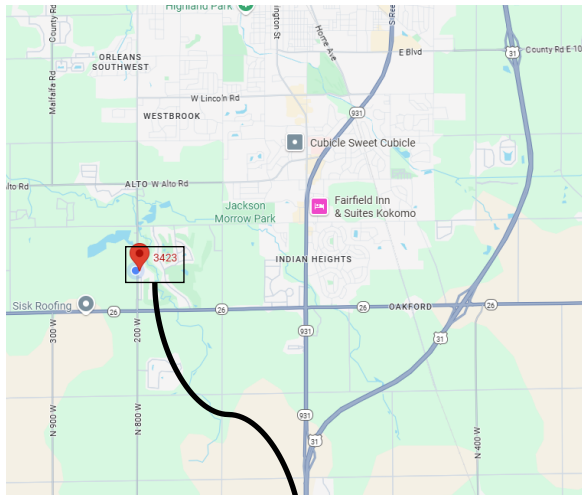

The layout is a single-track folded dog-bone layout with an automatic block control system. Three trains can run simultaneously and the two on the 150-foot main will run and pass automatically according to the route levers program. The layout includes lighted buildings, street/yard lights, flashing water tower lights, animated billboards, caboose/passenger cars constant-brightness lights, and sound effects that accent the layout scene.
